### How Can I Help Stop Health Care Fraud & Abuse?

Health care fraud and abuse takes money from healthcare programs which leaves less money for real medical care.

An example of provider fraud is billing for services, procedures, and/or supplies that were not provided. Examples of member fraud include the use of altered and/or stolen prescription pads or requesting or asking a transportation driver to take you to an unapproved location.

Here are some ways you can help stop fraud:

- Do not give your Molina Healthcare ID card or ID number to anyone other than a healthcare provider, clinic, or hospital and only when receiving care.
- Do not let anyone borrow your Molina Healthcare ID card. If someone else uses your ID card, this is fraud.
- Check your mail for medical bills for services that you did not receive.
