Medication Monitoring Categories

Drug/Condition Category	We look for these claims	Frequency of monitoring
ACE Inhibitors and ARBs	Lab panel, serum potassium and serum creatinine or blood urea nitrogen	Once per calendar year
Digoxin	Lab panel, serum potassium and serum creatinine or blood urea nitrogen	Once per calendar year
Diuretics	Lab panel, serum potassium and serum creatinine or blood urea nitrogen	Once per calendar year
Anticonvulsants	Serum drug concentration for phenobarb, carbamazepine, phenytoin and valproic acid or divalproex sodium	Once per calendar year
Members with an AMI, coronary artery bypass percutaneous coronary intervention or diagnosis of ischemic vascular disease	LDL screening and LDL less than 100 mg/dL	Once per calendar year
Members (female) who have had a fracture	Bone Mineral Density Test	Within 6 months of the fracture
