The ABCs of State of Michigan Carved out Drugs

All prescriptions for HIV/AIDS and psychotropic related medications in the following categories have been carved out 100% from health plan coverage since 2004 when the State of Michigan required coverage under the fee for service program:

- Antipsychotic, dopamine antagonist, iminodibenzyl derivative**
- Antipsychotic, atypical D2 partial agonist/5HT mixed**
- SSRI & antipsychotic, atypical combination**
- Antivirals for HIV**
- Disulfiram (Antabuse)**
- Naltrexone HCL (ReVia/Depade)**
- Acamprosate Calcium (Campral) -requires PA**
- Buprenorphine HCL/Naloxone HCL (Suboxone) -requires PA**
- ARTV CMB Nucleoside, Nucleotide & Non-Nucleoside (Atripla)**

Benefit coverage for these medications is determined by First Health Services. Please encourage your office staff to check the State of Michigan First Health site for any prior authorization requirements. Coverage of these medications is subject to state mandated changes.
