Dear Molina Healthcare Provider:

Molina Healthcare of New Mexico, Inc. (Molina Healthcare) is committed to ensuring that our providers are apprised of new and/or updated requirements.

The New Mexico Human Services Department (HSD) notified Molina Healthcare that Durable Medical Equipment (DME) and Medical Supplies regulation has been updated and finalized effective March 1, 2011.

With this regulation update, Molina Healthcare now requires that all DME providers confirm and document that eligible Members/Recipients do not have in excess of a fifteen (15) day supply of the item before releasing the next supply order. Below is the final regulation that requires this documentation of DME providers:

8.324.5.12 B NMAC

B. (1) A provider or medical supplier that routinely supplies an item to an eligible recipient must document that the order for additional supplies was requested by the recipient or their personal representative and the provider or supplier must confirm that the eligible recipient does not have in excess of a 15-calendar day supply of the item before releasing the next supply order to the eligible recipient. A provider must keep documentation in their files available for audit that show compliance with this requirement.
