**RE: CORRECTION LETTER – Immunization Incentives**

Dear Primary Care Practitioner:

**This is a correction to the letter dated March 3, 2009. The letter had an incorrect telephone contact number listed. Please disregard this telephone number. The correct telephone number to call to reach your designated Provider Services Representative for questions is (800) 377-9594. We apologize for any inconvenience this has caused.**

The provision of timely immunizations to the patients you care for is a very important service that you provide to our Members. To thank and encourage you to continue to improve immunization rates we are pleased to announce that for a limited time we will sponsor an incentive program that will begin in mid-March.

The program has three (3) components:

1. When you administer a vaccination and record the administration in the New Mexico Statewide Immunization Information System (NMSIIS) and submit a claim with code 99080 we will reimburse you \$20 instead of the usual \$5.
2. When you administer a vaccination and submit a claim with 90467, 90468, 90471 and 90472 we will increase the reimbursement \$100 for each unique vaccination administered. ***This is in addition to the standard reimbursement.***
3. For 2008, we will review overall immunization administration rates and develop threshold for eligibility to participate in an incentive pool for 2008 immunizations. Based on a practitioner/provider's performance compared to threshold level, you may receive an additional incentive payment.

**Please note:** This program will run through early June 2009 or until available funds are disbursed, **whichever comes first.**
