To: All Molina Healthcare of New Mexico, Inc. (Molina Healthcare) Practitioners who Administer Vaccinations to Children.

Re: Immunization Administration CPT-4 codes 90460 and 90461.

The development and implementation of the new CPT codes 90460 and 90461 on January 1, 2011 and implemented by Molina Healthcare of New Mexico, Inc. (Molina Healthcare) has been somewhat confusing for all involved.

Thank you valued Molina Healthcare practitioners/physicians for your feedback regarding the notification you received in April 2011. Based on this feedback, the following changes will be implemented.

EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011: BILLING FOR VACCINES FOR CHILDREN

Effective for dates of service on or after July 1, 2011:

Bill CPT 90460 for the first toxoid of each vaccination, and CPT 90461 for each additional toxoid. Molina Healthcare will continue to reimburse \$30.00 for 90460, and will process 90461 as inclusive to 90460.

90460 – Immunization administration through eighteen (18) years of age via any route of administration, with counseling by physician or other qualified health care professional; first vaccine/toxoid component

90461 – Each additional vaccine/toxoid component

When these vaccines are supplied to the provider by the Vaccines for Children Program (VFC) the Medicaid program does not make payment to the provider for the vaccine, but only for the service of injecting the vaccine.

Please make sure to bill the immunization CPT code along with the administration codes, even if you participate in VFC. This information is required in order to reimburse the administration codes.
