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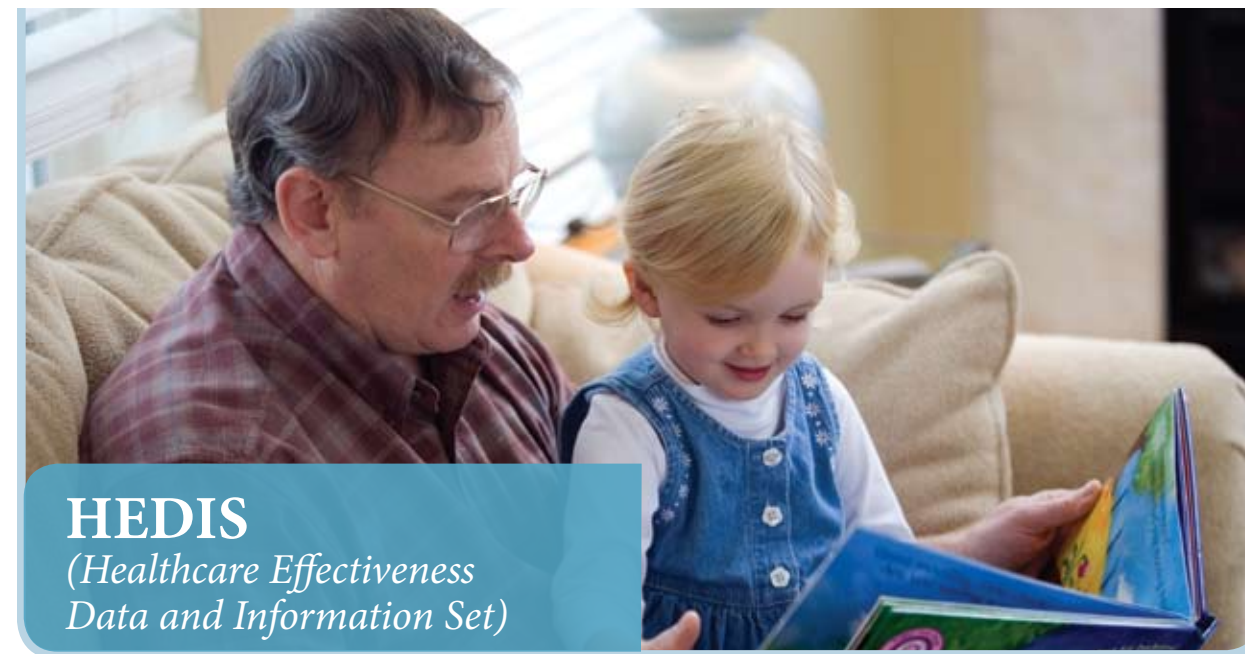

According to The National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA), a nonprofit organization committed to assessing, reporting on, and improving quality of care, HEDIS is the most widely used set of quality performance measures in the managed care industry.

Molina uses HEDIS reporting measures as a way of documenting preventive health care services that are provided to our members on an annual basis.

Molina requires all providers to submit encounter data reflecting the care and services provided to Molina members.

Each year many of our providers ask us:

- Is my participation required for HEDIS?
- How can we lessen the burden of medical record reviews in our office?

This tool is meant to answer those questions and to provide a quick desk reference for coding health care visits.

All providers contracted with Molina Healthcare of Ohio must submit medical record documentation, when requested, and complete and accurate claims in support of Molina's Quality Improvement Program. HEDIS reporting is a major component of the QI Program. Therefore, all Molina providers are contractually required to participate in HEDIS.

Our goal in providing this tool is to maximize the appropriate use of acceptable codes for quality reporting, particularly the CPT Category II codes. Please note that the codes in this tool are not the only applicable codes to use. The more complete and accurate coding on claims submissions, the less likely Molina will need to conduct medical record reviews for HEDIS data collection. Molina will continue to work with our providers to reduce the burden of medical record retrieval and/or review at their offices and to increase the volume of claim data for quality reporting.
