

Interqual Best Practices Guidelines for Pain Management Injections and MRI of the Spine

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The following information needs to be provided to Molina Healthcare either via fax, by completing the Service Request form (for Prior Authorization), or verbally:

- 1. Exam findings of weakness or pain of a spinal nerve origin, AND
- 2. Non-diagnostic X-ray imaging (not indicating arthritis or other disease), <u>AND</u>
- 3. Conservative care for 12 weeks or more:

- anti-inflammatory medication (naproxen, lbuprofen, etc.); dosage strength, daily frequency, & for duration given, <u>AND</u>

physical therapy; which modalities, frequency per week, & for duration

After at least 12 weeks of conservative treatment, an injection may be considered if there appears to be a delay in recovery. Most patients improve and recover with conservative care, without needing complex procedures or imaging.
