Three Decades of Delivering Access to Quality Care

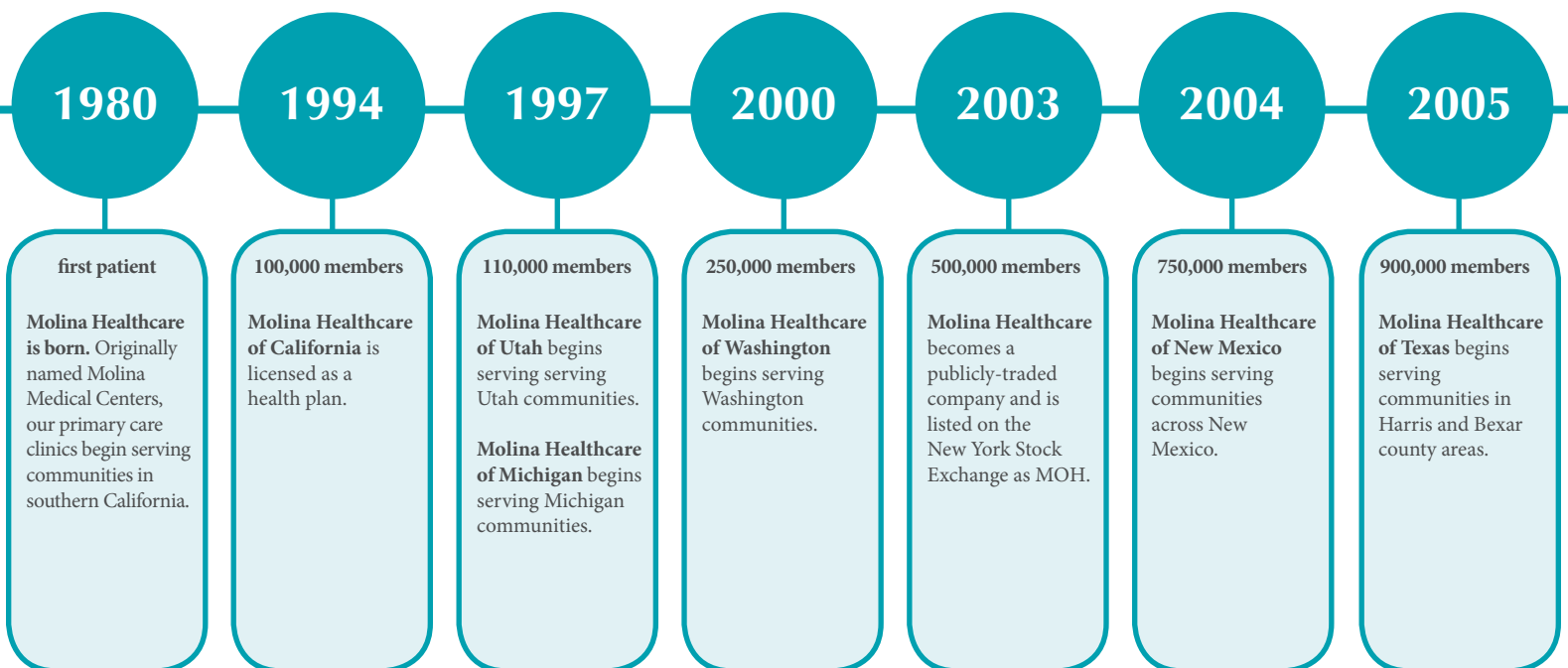
