## Pharmacy Recredentialing Expiration Notice (Medicaid)

## Dear Provider:

You are receiving this communication because your registration with the Washington State Health Care Authority (HCA) is expired or about to expire.

A federal regulation (42 C.F.R. 455.4 IO(b)) requires the Washington State Health Care Authority (HCA), as the state's Medicaid agency, to enroll <u>all</u> providers who are under contract with MCOs that serve Medicaid clients.

Should your registration lapse for any reason, your claims may be declined for payment. We encourage you to act promptly to get re-registered as quickly as possible.

## About this requirement:

 The federal regulation applies to all providers under contract with an MCO serving Medicaid clients, regardless of the type of service they provide. This means clinics, pharmacies, and other organizations contracted with an MCO as well as individual providers contracted with an MCO must enroll with HCA.
