Expedited Authorization (EA) Codes (Medicaid)

Molina Healthcare of Washington is an existing Plan Sponsor with CVS Caremark®.

The Expedited Authorization (EA) process is designed to eliminate the need to request authorization from Molina. The intent is to establish authorization criteria and associate these criteria with specific codes, enabling pharmacies to submit an "EA" number on the claim submission when appropriate.

Important:

To activate the EA code, the pharmacy must have a submitted claim with a rejected response that did not include the EA code being submitted. Once the pharmacy has received a rejected claim response, you may then re-submit the claim with the appropriate EA code (within the Prior Authorization Number Submitted NCPDP field # 462-EV).

Note: Use of an EA number does not exempt claims from early refills
