## Free Workshop – Earn CE Credits Problem Solving Treatment for Patients with Depression

**What is it?** This free, one-day workshop informs mental health professionals about Problem Solving Treatment (PST). PST teaches and empowers patients to solve the here-and-now problems contributing to their depression and helps increase self-efficacy.

Developed for use by medical professionals in primary care settings, an extensive evidence base shows that PST can effectively be provided in a wide range of settings and with a variety of providers and patient populations.
