## Department of Health Free Buprenorphine Waiver Trainings

Coming in May/June 2019

Molina Healthcare would like to inform our provider partners of upcoming buprenorphine waiver training courses scheduled throughout Washington in May and June. Trainings are sponsored by the Washington State Department of Health (DOH).

Each course is FREE. Upon completion of the 4-hour, in-person component and the 4-hour online follow-up, physicians can apply for waivers to prescribe buprenorphine for office-based treatment of opioid use disorder.

## UPCOMING BUPRENORPHRINE WAIVER TRAININGS

## as of March 22, 2019 (No cost)

Completion of the 4-hour in-person course as well as a 4-hour online follow-up allows physicians to apply for the waiver to prescribe buprenorphine for office-based treatment of opioid use disorder. ARNPs and PA-Cs require an additional 16 hours of training. CME is approved by American Academy of Addiction Psychiatry (AAAP) or American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM). Other interested professionals including RNs and chemical dependency counselors may attend upon approval of the course contact, listed below.
