Integrated Managed Care Service Encounter Reporting Instructions (SERI) Changes, Effective 7/1/2019

Molina would like to share information with our behavioral health agencies from the Health Care Authority (HCA) regarding updates made to the Service Encounter Reporting Instructions (SERI) for Integrated Managed Care effective 7/1/2019. The changes will be formally added to the next release of the SERI guide, expected to occur on 10/1/2019.

Overview of Updates:

- Peer Support has been added as a modality to Substance Use Services modalities section
- Coding instructions have been added to the Mental Health Peer Services modality on pages 57-58.
- Urinalysis Codes have been added to Substance Use Service modalities section
- Non-Medicaid code for Urinalysis has been added
- Modifier XE has been added to the Procedure Modifier Index Page
