


Learning Hub User Guide

To create your Psych Hub account and access our **Learning Hub** follow the instructions below.


1. How to join the Molina Healthcare Cohort Using a **Cohort Code** and access Psych Hub's Learning Hubs:

Order	Action
Step 1	Go to https://lms.psychhub.com/
Step 2	<p>Create a user account by clicking Log In on the top right hand corner of the screen. Log in to Psych Hub's LMS.</p> 
Step 3	<p>Click the Dashboard button on the navigation toolbar.</p> 
Step 4	<p>Scroll down on the right-hand side of the screen to the Join Cohort with Code block</p>

	
Step 6	<p>Enter Cohort Code and click the Submit Cohort Code button.</p> <p>Molina Healthcare Cohort Code for providers: SGDcuXXmQXZEGsu</p>
Step 7	<p>A “Success” message or a “Code not Found” message will appear</p>
Step 8	<p>When you receive the Success message, you will automatically be enrolled in all courses. To verify, check the available courses in the My Courses tab at the top of the screen. All courses will be shown in this drop-down menu.</p>



Course Modules

For some courses, when the learner enters the Course Modules section, they are required to take a **Pre-Course Assessment**. Learners are permitted one attempt before moving on to the Course Modules.

- This module focuses on the initial phases of treatment. We see Roger in an early phase session with his therapist.*

	<p>After the learner has completed all the Learning Hub (course) modules, they will take the Post-Course Assessment. The learner is allowed unlimited attempts to pass the assessment. They must receive a passing grade of 85% or higher.</p> <p>After the Post-Course Assessment has been passed, the learner must complete the Participant Evaluation. It must be completed in order to receive a completion certificate for the course.</p> <p>After the Participant Evaluation has been submitted, the learner will receive an email with their course completion certificate. This will be available to you in the learning platform in the Manage Badges section (https://lms.psychhub.com/badges/mybadges.php) You will also receive an official copy of your badge in an email that will be sent after completing the courses. You may post this badge on your LMS profile, email signature, or any professional platform.</p>
