How Providers Can Prepare for Senate Bill 249 GRT Reimbursement Changes

Effective January 1, 2026, Senate Bill 249 (SB249) brings important changes to how Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) reimburse health care providers for Gross Receipts Taxes (GRT) on Medicaid health care services in New Mexico. Here is what you need to know:

What Is Changing?

- Molina Healthcare of New Mexico (Molina) will reimburse providers for applicable GRT that
 providers are required to pay on contracted health care services. This reimbursement will be
 clearly delineated from the Medicaid payment for health care services on the provider's
 Remittance Advice.
- The Remittance Advice will include an itemized entry for the GRT amount applied to the total claim, displayed on a separate line using HCPCS code S9999. This approach ensures transparency and clarity in payment documentation.

Current State:

At present, Molina incorporates the applicable GRT into the negotiated rate with providers.
 Claims are processed and paid at this contracted rate, which includes the GRT; however, the GRT is not itemized separately on the Remittance Advice.

Future State:

- Molina will issue an Amendment to all impacted providers to update the Compensation Attachment in compliance with SB249. This Amendment will ensure that the GRT is listed separately from the contracted rate.
- Molina's claims system will be updated to reflect the current GRT Tax Schedule published by NM Taxation and Revenue Department. The Remittance Advice will clearly display the GRT payment as distinct from the contracted rate payment using HCPCS Code S9999 for identification.



What Providers Should Do:

- Watch for the upcoming Amendment to your Compensation Attachment via email and/or regular mail and review it carefully.
- Beginning on January 1, 2026, check your Remittance Advice to ensure GRT is itemized separately.
