A Developmental Approach to Promote Dietary Diversity in Young Children

In this session, Dr. Heinig, Director of the Human Lactation Center at UC Davis, will provide an overview of a simple developmental approach that can be used by parents to promote dietary diversity among older babies and toddlers.
