What is Transitional Rent?

Transitional Rent is a short-term housing support available through Molina Healthcare of California's Medi-Cal Community Supports program. It helps members pay for permanent and interim housing when they are leaving a hospital, treatment program, or unsafe living situation and need time to find a more stable place to live.

This service is meant to support health, safety, and recovery during a housing transition.

Who may be eligible?

You may qualify for Transitional Rent if you meet all the following:

- Are enrolled in Medi-Cal with Molina Healthcare of California
- Are experiencing homelessness or are at risk of losing housing
- Meet County Behavioral Health Services Act (BHSA) eligibility requirements
- Have a medical, behavioral health, or social need that makes housing support necessary
- Are not already receiving another program that pays for rent
- Have not exhausted 182-day Global Cap for Short-Term Post Hospitalization, Recuperative Care, and Transitional Rent for the demonstration period

Transitional Rent is temporary and is not long-term funding.

What does Transitional Rent cover?

Transitional Rent may help pay for:

- Temporary rent for an apartment, room, or other approved housing
- Short-term housing support while long-term housing is being arranged

All services must meet Medi-Cal and county requirements and are approved for a limited time.

How do I request Transitional Rent or additional information?
