Now available at no cost for your Molina Medi-Cal teen patients, aged 13-19.

What is BeMe Health?

BeMe is a science-backed mental health app created for teens. Developed with child and adolescent mental health experts, BeMe combines psychoeducational content, skill-building activities, live mental health coaching, and 24/7 crisis support (including safety planning!). BeMe also facilitates connections to innetwork therapist directly through the app.

- **Coaching:** BeMe coachers provide real-time, text-based support, helping teens learn and practice coping and resilience-building skills even on nights and weekends. Real human connections (no bots)!
- Content: BeMe's teens have continuous access to science-backed skills based on DBT, CBT, positive psychology, and more – designed by clinicians,
- **Crisis:** Teens have access to 24/7 support: Safety Planning, BeMe's Crisis Hotline, Crisis Text Line, and The Trevor Project.
- **Care:** BeMe links teens as needed to virtual clinical care from behavioral health clinicians specializing in adolescents.

Who's a Good Fit for BeMe Health?

In short, all teens! Our referring providers find that BeMe is an excellent tool for the following patients who:

- Have symptoms of mental health conditions but don't have timely access to services
- Are going through the ups and downs of being a teen
- Are in clinical services and need more support between visits, or are on waitlists
