Model of Care (MOC) Provider Training

Molina Healthcare of Iowa is required to provide training regarding our Model of Care program for SNP enrollees. The MOC is the foundation for Molina's care management policy, procedures, and operational systems for our SNP population.

To ensure that Molina remains compliant with Centers for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS) regulatory requirements for MOC training, receipt of a completed Attestation Form is due to Molina no later than June 1, 2026.

What you need to do

Note: If one Attestation form is being returned for a group or clinic, it must be signed by an individual with the authority to sign on behalf of the group/clinic and an attendance roster indicating which providers completed the training must be attached.
