<b>Description:</b> <p>The Payment Integrity and Recovery Program addresses the reimbursement of Current Procedural Terminology (CPT®) and Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) codes for Vitamin D deficiencies that are the result of dietary inadequacy, impaired absorption and use, increased requirement, or increased excretion. Vitamin D deficiency can occur when usual intake is lower than recommended levels over a period, or when exposure to sunlight is limited. Vitamin D deficiency can also result from the inability of the kidneys to convert Vitamin D to its active form.</p> <p>Documentation must justify the test(s) chosen for a particular disease entity. A claim billed for Vitamin D Testing service <b>must</b> include a valid ICD-10-CM diagnosis code. If a valid ICD-10-CM diagnosis code is not billed, the Vitamin D service will be denied.</p> <p>Providers should refer to the Centers for Medicare &amp; Medicaid Services (CMS) for a list of valid diagnosis codes. This list may not be all-inclusive since American Medical Association (AMA) and CMS code updates may occur more frequently than policy updates.</p> <p>Molina will recover reimbursement for any claims previously reimbursed for Vitamin D without a valid diagnosis code. Molina is currently working to improve claims systems logic to deny reimbursement for current and future claims.</p>
<b>Example Scenario:</b> <p>Claim A billed with 82306 without a qualifying diagnosis code <b>will not</b> be reimbursable.</p>
