

# Provider Memorandum

## Important Quarterly Updates to Molina’s Prior Authorization (PA) Requirements

**Effective April 1, 2021**, the codes listed in the table below will **require** Prior Authorization. This change will be reflected on the Molina Healthcare of Illinois (Molina) Prior Authorization Codification List found on the [Molina website for providers](#) on the [Frequently Used Forms](#) page, under Authorization Requests. The downloadable document lists the Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) and Healthcare Common Procedural Coding System (HCPCS) codes that require a PA.

The document is updated quarterly, and providers are **strongly** encouraged to review all updates regularly.

**Important Note:** For any PA changes due to regulatory guidance related to COVID-19, please see provider notifications and the most current information on the Molina Provider Portal.

As introduced in [this October 2020 provider memorandum](#), Molina has launched a [PA LookUp Tool](#) to help you find the correct codes. It is intended for **searches only** and should **not** be used to make determinations about coverage.

The PA Tool is for outpatient services **only**. All elective inpatient admissions to acute hospitals, Skilled Nursing Facilities (SNF), rehabilitation facilities, or long-term acute care hospitals require Prior Authorization.
