



Passport by Molina Healthcare Well Child Participating Provider Sweepstakes **Frequently Asked Questions**

Q: What is the Well Child Sweepstakes?

A: Eligible Providers who achieve NCQA 50th percentile for HEDIS Child and Adolescent Well-Care Visits (WCV) for the measurement year 2026 will be entered into a raffle for a chance to win a DCA Vantage HbA1c Analyzer and a CardioChek Plus Analyzer Promo Pack to complete HbA1cs and Cholesterol labs at the point of care.

Q: What is the purpose of the Well Child Sweepstakes?

A: To improve Child and Adolescent Well-Care Visits Passport Medicaid members in the 2026 measurement year.

Q: What will the providers win?

A: DCA Vantage HbA1c Analyzer and a CardioChek Plus Analyzer Promo Pack will be awarded to five (5) provider groups.

Q: What is a DCA Vantage HbA1c Analyzer?

A: The DCA Vantage Analyzer is a CLIA-waived point-of-care system for diabetes care and screening. It helps providers monitor glycemic control and detect early kidney disease.

Q: What is a CardioChek Plus Analyzer?

A: A CardioChek Plus Analyzer is a fast, portable and accurate whole blood test system designed to enable physicians to test for dyslipidemia and take action to bring lipids under control while their patients are in the office.

Q: What is the purpose of this equipment?

A: Winners will have the ability to improve well child visits with the DCA Vantage HbA1c Analyzer and CardioChek Plus Analyzer by offering labs at the point of care. Benefits include:

- Helps to improve patient health outcomes
- Offers quick, lab work during routine primary care office visits
- Saves patients the time and expense of a separate visit for lab work
- Achieve NCQA® HEDIS® quality measures for WCV and APM-E.
- Improve total cost of care with early detection and treatment

Q: What is the value of the DCA Vantage HbA1c Analyzer?

A: Each DCA Vantage HbA1c Analyzer has an estimated prize value of \$3,300.

Q: What is the value of the CardioChek Plus Analyzer?

A: Each CardioChek Plus Analyzer has an estimated prize value of \$1,200.

Q: Are the DCA Vantage HbA1c Analyzer and CardioChek Plus Analyzer CLIA-Waived?

A: Yes, they are both CLIA-waived. The DCA Vantage HbA1c Analyzer is a CLIA-waived HbA1c test that is IFCC and NGSP-certified. The CardioChek PA is CLIA-waived under the Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments of 1988 and CRMLN Certified.

Q: Who is eligible to participate in the Well Child Sweepstakes?

A: Any physician practice meeting all the criteria below:

- Contracted to see Passport Medicaid members.
- Not employed by a hospital.
- Have a KY location.
- Minimum of ten Passport members assigned to them in the WCV denominator.
- Physicians must not have an immediate family member or live in the same household as a Passport employee.

Q: What is the timeline for Well Child Sweepstakes?

A: Sweepstakes will begin in Q1 2026. Providers will have until December 31st, 2026 to enter into sweepstakes.

- Quality team will provide baseline and mid-year reports to all groups that participate in the program.
- Results will be evaluated in May 2027.
- Winners will be announced in June 2027.
