Independent Pharmacy Pricing Methodology Changes Effective 02/01/2026

Molina Healthcare of Nebraska is alerting pharmacy providers that changes have been made to the pricing methodology for brand and generic drugs dispensed by independent pharmacies (as defined by NE Code § 68-9,111)

Effective 02/01/2026, brand and generic drugs dispensed by independent pharmacies will transition to a National Average Drug Acquisition Cost (NADAC) based pricing methodology. This model directly aligns with the Nebraska Department of Health & Human Services, Division of Medicaid & Long-Term Care fee-for-service framework as defined in 471 Nebraska Administrative Code § 16-015.04. This methodology change aims to promote transparent, fair, and data driven reimbursement for our independent pharmacy partners. A summary of general NADAC pricing principles may be found below:

- Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) benchmark that is calculated using a monthly voluntary survey of participants' actual acquisition costs.
- Rates are updated on a weekly basis and use a three-month moving average (for generics only) to mitigate price volatility and changes in monthly reporting.
- Replaces generic MAC pricing to ensure transparent reimbursement.

CVS Caremark sent a network enrollment form to all affected independent pharmacy partners through their preferred network communication channels.
