

Use of ASAM Criteria® for SUD Treatment in Hospitals Information for providers in the Medicaid and MyCare Ohio networks

Effective Oct. 5, 2020, Molina will utilize American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM) Criteria® for all members receiving Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Treatment, including the inpatient hospital level of care.

This change is in accordance with the "<u>Use of ASAM Criteria</u> in <u>Hospital Settings</u>" memo released by the Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) on July 8, 2020, available on the ODM website at https://medicaid.ohio.gov, under "Managed Care" select "For Managed Care Plans" then "Guidance."

Providers should include supportive ASAM Criteria[®] clinical documentation with requests for admissions for any member receiving SUD Treatment/withdrawal management to ensure the review is completed as quickly as possible.
