ACE Inhibitor ± Diuretic Combinations	Benazepril ± Hydrochlorothiazide, Captopril ± Hydrochlorothiazide, Enalapril ± Hydrochlorothiazide, Fosinopril ± Hydrochlorothiazide, Lisinopril ± Hydrochlorothiazide, Quinapril ± Hydrochlorothiazide, Trandolapril, Ramipril
Adrenolytics, Central	Clonidine tablets, Guanfacine
Alpha Blockers	Doxazosin, Prazosin, Terazosin
Antilipemics	Cholestyramine can, Colestipol tablets, generic Fenofibrate 48mg, 54mg, 145mg, 160mg, Gemfibrozil, Atorvastatin, Lovastatin, Pravastatin, Simvastatin (5 mg, 10 mg, 20 mg and 40 mg),
Antiarrhythmics	Amiodarone 200 mg, Disopyramide, Flecainide, Propafenone, Sotalol
ARBs ± Diuretic Combinations	Irbesartan ± Hydrochlorothiazide, Losartan ± Hydrochlorothiazide, Valsartan± Hydrochlorothiazide
Beta Blockers ± Diuretic Combinations	Acebutolol, Atenolol ± Chlorthalidone, Bisoprolol ± Hydrochlorothiazide, Carvedilol, Labetalol, Metoprolol, Propranolol, Nadolol
Calcium Channel Blockers	Amlodipine, Felodipine ER (2.5 mg, 5 mg, 10 mg), Nifedipine, Nifedipine ER Diltiazem, Diltiazem ER, Verapamil, Verapamil ER
Digitalis Glycosides	Digoxin 0.125 mg, 0.25 mg, Digoxin Solution
Diuretics	Acetazolamide, Acetazolamide ER, Bumetanide, Furosemide solution and tablets, Torsemide, Amiloride ± Hydrochlorothiazide, Chlorthalidone, Hydrochlorothiazide ± Triamterene, Indapamide, Metolazone, Spironolactone ± Hydrochlorothiazide
Nitrates	Isosorbide Dinitrate 5 mg, 10 mg, 20 mg, 30 mg, Isosorbide Mononitrate, Isosorbide Mononitrate ER, Nitroglycerin ER, Nitroglycerin Sublingual, Nitroglycerin Transdermal

The following medications have step therapy or require prior authorization:

Drug Class	Preferred Medications
Antilipemics	Lovaza, Vascepa, Pitavastatin, Repatha, Praluent
Miscellaneous	Xarelto, Eliquis, Brilinta, Effient, Entresto, Ranolazine ER
