Washington State Autism Center of Excellence (COE) Certificate Training: September 29, 2023 (Medicaid)

Center of Excellence (COE) certification allows eligible providers* to diagnose autism spectrum disorder for pediatric patients with Medicaid. This training requires the completion of a prerequisite course.**

- Accessing community and state resources
- Documentation, billing codes and orders

- Autistic and family advocates lived experience perspectives
- Advice from current community COE clinicians

PhD/PsyD Psychologists, Neurologists, Psychiatrists and Developmental Behavioral Pediatricians are automatically eligible. Other partners in the evaluation process and follow up supports are also welcome to register.
