The MolinaCares Community Champions Awards program was created to honor people whose leadership, volunteerism, and public advocacy embody the spirit of compassion and service.

Winners each receive a \$5,000 grant for the nonprofit organization of their choice and a trophy. At the awards event, we recognize these Community Champions and showcase the extraordinary work of the nominating agencies and grant recipients.

HOW ARE PEOPLE NOMINATED?

Organizations and community members nominate volunteers or employees who improve the health and lives of underserved communities by working to create more equitable health care and social systems.

HOW ARE WINNERS SELECTED?

A panel of judges reviews nominees and selects winners based on the following criteria:

- Overall community contributions and involvement in efforts to advance equity and address issues that affect health disparities
- Achievements or qualities that show a nominee's commitment to serving those in need
- Specific results demonstrating the positive influence a nominee's activities have had on the community
