Molina Earns 5 Stars from External Quality Review Agency, MetaStar

Every year, the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) contracts with external quality review agency MetaStar, Inc. to provide independent evaluation of managed care organization compliance with federal Medicaid managed care regulations and our DHS contract.



In September, Molina Healthcare of Wisconsin (dba My Choice Wisconsin) received the final FY24-25 Annual Quality Review Report from MetaStar for our Family Care and Family Care Partnership Programs. **The overall score was 95.5%, or five stars!**

Molina tied with another plan as the highest-scoring MCO in the state this year. Our Care Management Review results also surpassed the statewide average in both programs. This score reflects our team's commitment to providing high-quality care.

Member concerns

- When Case Manager Chantel first spoke to Camila's* dad Aaden* about a well-child visit, she learned he had 7 other children under age 18!
- He also had much larger concerns: unreliable transportation, limited access to fresh food, issues with his WIC card, and a desire to connect with his faith community in a new setting.

- Chantel completed assessments for all 8 children, with the assistance of an interpreter.
- She also linked him to transportation, a local food pantry, a WIC representative for troubleshooting and appointments, and churches offering services in Swahili.
