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CHP Capitation – Monthly Membership Report File Layout Update

This is an advisory notification to Central Health Medicare Plan (CHP) network providers applicable to CHP Medicare business.

What you need to know:

Please note that the Monthly Membership Report (MMR) file layout has been updated to align with the latest Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) MMR file layout.

CMS has revised the MMR Detail data file layout to expand the Part A, Part B, and Part D Risk Adjustment Factor fields from 7 bytes to 8 bytes.

When this is happening:

This change will take effect with the August capitation payment.
