Prenatal Care Visits with a PCP or OB/GYN

Prenatal visits should begin as soon as the pregnancy is confirmed or immediately after the member is enrolled. Molina Healthcare provides dental services to pregnant women ages 19 to 64. Pregnant Medicaid members will be able to use their Molina Healthcare Medicaid ID to obtain services.

This ensures they receive educational materials and enrollment in the enhanced Medicaid benefit which provides dental coverage during pregnancy through 90 days after they deliver.
