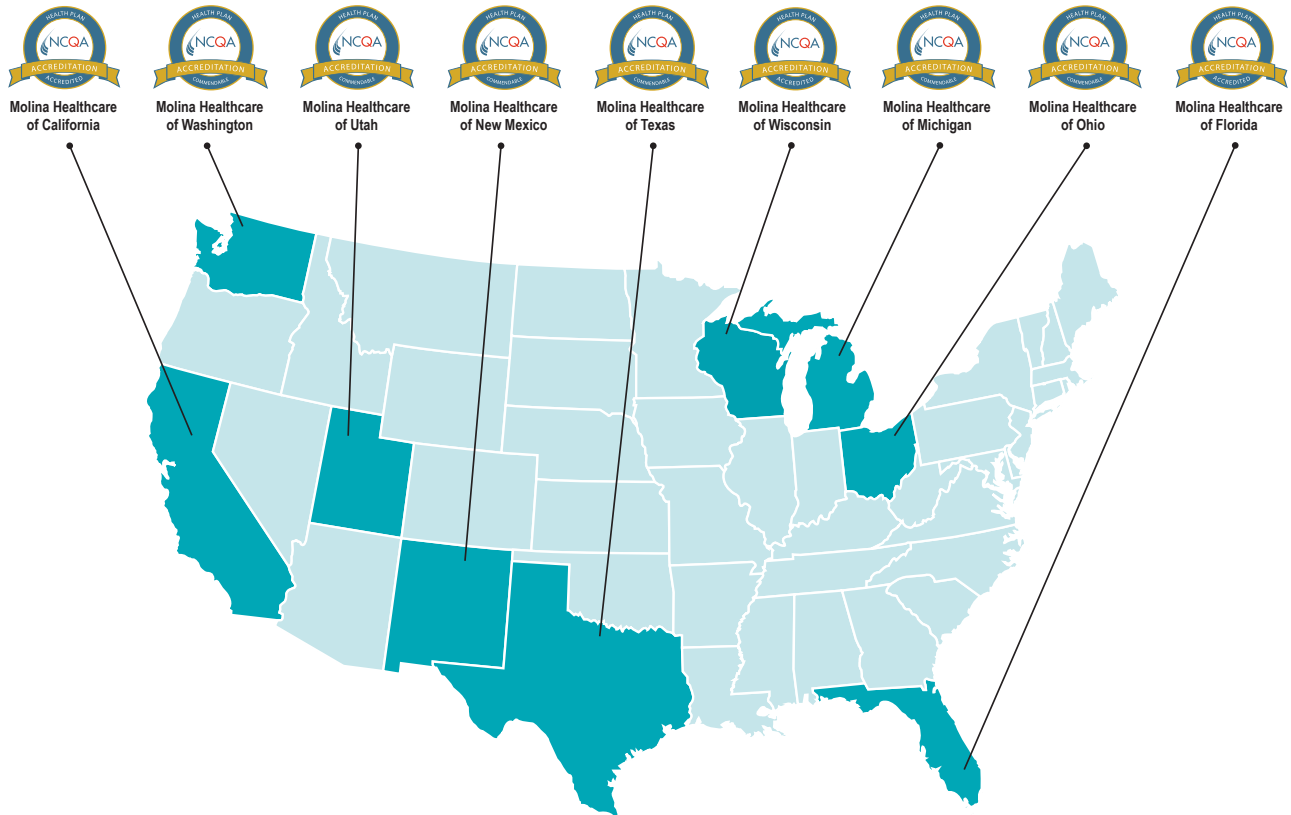


Molina Healthcare's NCQA Quality Highlights

Mission and Values

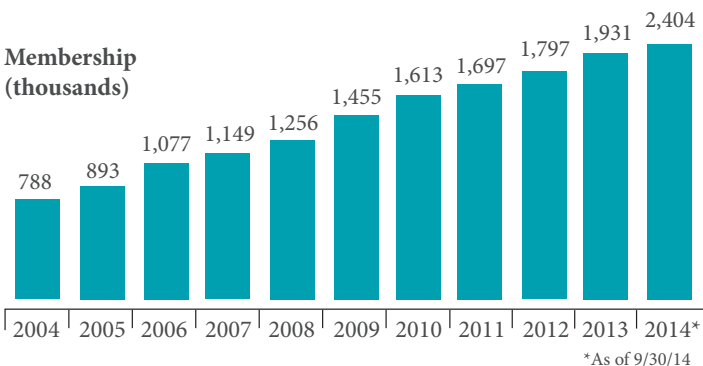

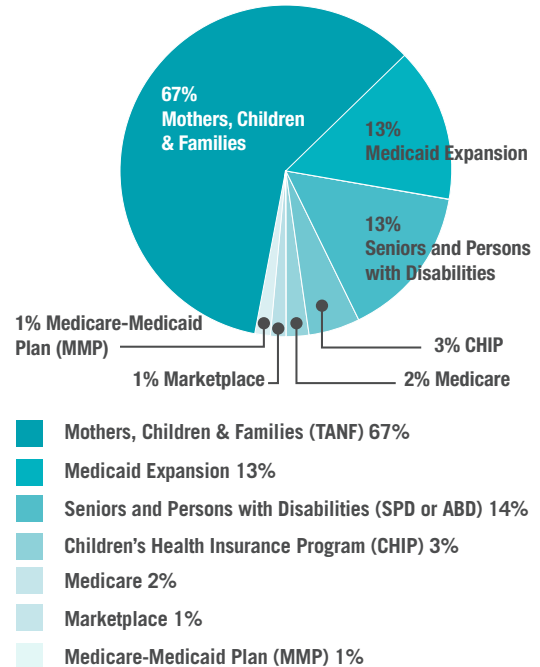
