What is the overall deductible ?	\$3,000 Individual or \$6,000/family	See the Common Medical Events chart below for your costs for services this plan covers.
Are there services covered before you meet your deductible ?	Yes. Preventive care , Family Planning, Pediatric Vision, Hospice, Home Healthcare services and Formulary Preventive Prescription Drugs are covered before you meet your deductible	For example, this plan covers certain preventive services without cost sharing and before you meet your deductible . See a list of covered preventive services at https://www.healthcare.gov/coverage/preventive-care-benefits/ .
Are there other deductibles for specific services?	No	You don't have to meet deductibles for specific services.
What is the out-of-pocket limit for this plan ?	For network providers \$5,850 individual / \$11,700 family; for out-of-network providers there is no coverage unless Prior Authorized by Molina Healthcare.	The out-of-pocket limit is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this plan , they have to meet their own out-of-pocket limits until the overall family out-of-pocket limit has been met.
What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit ?	Premiums , balance-billing charges, and health care this plan doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the out-of-pocket limit .
Will you pay less if you use a network provider ?	Yes. See MolinaMarketplace.com or call 1-888-560-2025 for a list of network providers .	This plan uses a provider network . You will pay less if you use a provider in the plan's network . You will pay the most if you use an out-of-network provider , and you might receive a bill from a provider for the difference between the provider's charge and what your plan pays (balance billing). Be aware, your network provider might use an out-of-network provider for some services (such as lab work). Check with your provider before you get services.
Do you need a referral to see a specialist ?	No.	You can see the specialist you choose without a referral .

Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes

If you don't have [Minimum Essential Coverage](#) for a month, you'll have to make a payment when you file your tax return unless you qualify for an exemption from the requirement that you have health coverage for that month.

Does this plan meet the Minimum Value Standards? Yes

Peg is Having a Baby

(9 months of in-network pre-natal care and a hospital delivery)

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In this example, Joe would pay:

Copayments	\$1,400
Coinsurance	\$400
<i>What isn't covered</i>	
Limits or exclusions	\$60

Mia's Simple Fracture

(in-network emergency room visit and follow up care)
