## Get well, stay healthy

One of the best ways to stay well is by getting annual checkups and regular screenings. This helps your doctor catch problems early when they may be easier to treat. Here is a guide for how often you should get screenings and services, and how soon your doctor should be able to schedule your appointments. If you need help scheduling an appointment, call the number on the back of your member ID card.

| Adult preventive visits   | Age 20 and older (yearly)   |
| Well-baby visits  | 6 or more visits before 15 months   |
| Well-child visits   | Ages 3 to 20 years  |
| Prenatal visits   | Series of visits before delivery  |
| Post-delivery visits  | Between 7 to 84 days after delivery   |
| Mammogram (checks for breast cancer)  | Women 50 to 74 years (yearly)   |
| Pap Test (checks for cervical cancer)   | Women 21 to 64 years, as recommended by your doctor                                 |
| Colonoscopy (checks for colon cancer)   | Ages 50 to 75 years, as recommended by your doctor                                  |
| Diabetic testing (A1c test, kidney test, eye exam)  | Ask your doctor how often you need these tests                                      |
| Behavioral health visit after hospitalization   | 1 to 7 days after discharge   |
| Flu shot  | Yearly  |
| Dental visit  | Once every six months   |
| Vision visit  | Yearly  |
| Type of visit   | How long will it take to get an appointment?  |
| Emergency Services  | Immediately   |
| Urgent Care Service, including urgent specialty care and<br>Behavioral Health Services      | Within 24 hours   |
| Primary Routine Care  | Within 14 days  |
| Specialty Routine Care  | Within 21 days  |
| Initial Outpatient Behavioral Health Visits   | Within 14 days  |
| Community Long-Term Services and Supports   | Must be initiated with 7 days from the start date on the<br>Individual Service Plan |
| Prenatal Care   | Within 14 days for initial appointments   |
| Prenatal Care for High Risk pregnancies or new members in the third trimester               | Within 5 days   |
| Preventive health services, including annual adult well checks for members age 21 and older | Within 90 days  |
| Preventive health services children   | Within 14 days for members less than 6 months of age                                |
|   | Within 60 days for members 6 months through age 20                                  |
| Case Management for Children and Pregnant Women   | Within 14 days  |



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
