

**APPEAL REQUEST FORM**

If you don't agree with the decision Molina Complete Care (MCC) has made on a service request or payment issue, you have the right to appeal. You may also file an appeal with the Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS) Appeals Division, but you must file an appeal with MCC first. You have 60 calendar days from the date on the service letter or payment decision to appeal. After 60 calendar days, it is too late to appeal the decision. If you ask for an appeal by calling us, you must also send your request to us in writing within 10 days. Below is a form to assist you in making your appeal request in writing. You can provide it to our pharmacy vendor, Magellan Rx, in person or in writing to:
