## **Important update from Molina Healthcare**

### **Upcoming CALOCUS Training Changes Effective February 13, 2025**

Beginning February 13, 2025, self-paced CALOCUS training will be offered by the American Academy of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry (AACAP).

At this time, AACAP and the American Association for Community Psychiatry (AACP) have partnered on the CALOCUS-CASII. As a result, all CALOCUS training will now be conducted by AACAP. AHCCCS has contracted with AACAP to provide this new online, self-paced training at no cost to providers.

Important Deadlines:

- The Deerfield and AACP training previously available since August 2024 will no longer be accessible after February 28, 2025.
- Providers who have already started this training must complete the module and competency test by March 14, 2025.

### **How to Access the New AACAP CALOCUS Training:**

#### **Entering the Promo Code for the Course:**

1. Visit AACAP's online store to view available training courses: [www.aacap.org/store-onlineEC](http://www.aacap.org/store-onlineEC)
2. Select "CALOCUS-CASII" and click "Add to Cart."
3. Click "Proceed to Checkout."
- Existing AACAP Users: Log in using your AACAP account credentials.
- New Users: Click "Create a New Account" to set up an AACAP profile.
4. During checkout, enter promo code: AHCCCSFREE and click "Apply" to receive a 100% discount.

#### **Accessing the Course:**

1. Visit AACAP's Pathways learning system: [www.aacap.org/pathways](http://www.aacap.org/pathways)
2. Click "Access Your Courses."
3. Log in with your AACAP account credentials.
4. Your enrolled courses will be displayed on the left side of the screen.

#### **Additional Training Information:**

- The new CALOCUS training takes approximately 6 hours to complete.
- A certificate of completion will be issued upon successful completion.
- This certificate must be uploaded into RELIAS for training credit.
