TRAINING OPPORTUNITY: ASTHMA EDUCATOR INSTITUTE

This is a notification to Molina Healthcare of California (MHC) network providers regarding an upcoming training opportunity for "Educating Professionals to Provide Care for Asthma Patients and Families".

This 2-day development course reviews National Institutes of Health (NIH) asthma guidelines-based asthma education for patients and their families. The curriculum covers the content outlined in the NAECP exam and includes case reviews, hands-on skills demonstration and practice. The course is delivered by asthma experts, including physicians, nurses and certified asthma educators.

This course meets the qualifications for 11.0 continuing education units provided by Loma Linda University.

By the end of this two-day course the participants will be able to:

1. Describe the six priority action steps for asthma case management
2. Apply motivational interviewing techniques
3. Use the Asthma Action plan as a self-management tool with patients
4. Demonstrate how to use various asthma medications
5. Recognize stepwise therapy and charts for control & severity
6. Apply the NHBLI and NAEPP guideline-directed asthma care to patients, families, and healthcare providers across all settings.
7. Identify the various roles of the asthma educator
8. Define the need to network with other healthcare providers, educators, and organizations surrounding asthma care and asthma care policies
9. Review and recognize pertinent information that will guide them towards sitting for the NAECP exam.

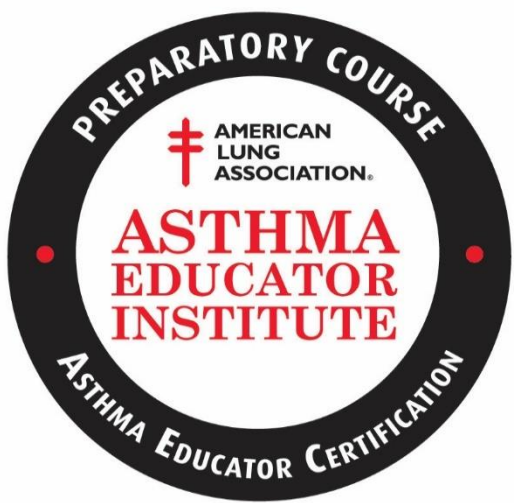
