



## Gold Card Program Requirements

As a component of the Utilization Management Program, Molina Healthcare of Florida has implemented a program for providers that reduces or eliminates service authorization requirements for high performing providers that meet quality performance criteria.

A **High Performing Provider** under our incentive program is based on the criteria below:

- Authorization volume
- Adverse determination percentage (< 5%)
- Related performance measures (Admission/K, ER/K other related metrics)

Services that qualify for inclusion in the program will be limited based on (1) overall utilization (2) per unit costs (3) potential for misuse and harm to the member.

Services eligible for the program currently include:

- Targeted Case Management
- Psychosocial Rehabilitation

### **How We Monitor Progress**

Molina will utilize authorization and claims data to review physician performance on a semi-annual basis to re-evaluate existing High Performing Providers for ongoing program management. In the event one of the three program participation criteria requirements are not met, providers will be removed from the program and notified in advance of removal.
