Molina Healthcare of Illinois offers free provider education courses for health credits

Molina Healthcare (Molina) has launched a series of free online Continuing Medical Education (CME) courses for primary care providers who wish to expand their medical knowledge.

The online training program is part of a partnership between Molina and the University of California, Irvine, to help train providers on how to document some of the nation's most important health conditions. Providers who complete online courses may earn CME credits as well as Maintenance of Certification (MOC, for Internal Medicine board certification). Providers may earn up to one CME credit per completed course. Each online course is separated into four different training modules. The first full online course may be completed in about one hour.

The first course focuses on diabetes mellitus documentation training and will help providers:

- Ensure patients receive evidence-based care
- Report HEDIS® measures more easily and accurately
- Master the use of approved documentation codes to help improve HEDIS® scores
- Receive CME credit and MOC credit for Internal Medicine board certification, upon course completion.
