Required 2019 Model of Care Training

Molina Healthcare of Illinois (Molina) is required to provide annual training to Medicare-Medicaid contracted providers, regarding its Model of Care program for dual eligible members.

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) requires all contracted providers and staff receive basic training about the Medicare and Medicaid Program (MMP) Model of Care.

Line of Business: Model of Care training applies to Medicare-Medicaid (Dual Option) Plan.

What is Model of Care training?

The MMP Model of Care is the plan for delivering coordinated care and care management to members in the MMP line of business. Health plans who offer the MMP line of business are responsible for conducting their own Model of Care training, which means you may be asked to complete multiple trainings by different health plans.

Complete Model of Care Training by November 30, 2019

To ensure Molina remains compliant with CMS regulatory requirements for Model of Care training, receipt of completed Attestation Form is due to Molina no later than **November 30, 2019**.
