## **Immunization Home Visit Referral Program**

Molina Healthcare has implemented and launched its Immunization Home Visit Referral Program. This initiative was designed for children between the ages of 18 - 23 months, who have not returned to their primary care provider or local health department for their final immunizations or first lead test due to transportation, child care, or other issues.

Molina has partnered with the MDHHS Immunization Program and Oakland County Health Dept. to sponsor Michigan Community Visiting Nurses Association (VNA) to become a Vaccine for Children (VFC) provider so that they can offer these valuable services to our members.

Molina Healthcare's Quality Interventions Team will review the incoming referrals, confirm the child's eligibility for the program, and forward the information to the VNA so the home visit can be scheduled.

In order for the member to receive a home visit, they must:

- Live in Wayne, Oakland, Macomb or Genesee County
- Be able to complete the Combination 3 (CO3)\* Immunization Series in one visit
  - Need one or more of the three immunizations listed below:  
DTap (4<sup>th</sup> Dose)    HiB (3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> Dose)    PCV (4<sup>th</sup> Dose)
  - All other shots in the CO3 series must already be up-to-date.
- Be available to receive immunization(s) and/or Lead Test on or before their second birthdate.

The assigned Primary Care Physician will receive credit for the immunization as it pertains to the HEDIS quality bonus.
