Common Medicaid Pharmacy Formulary

Effective June 1, 2016

The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) will implement a formulary that is common across all Medicaid health plans effective June 1, 2016. The purpose of the Common Formulary is to:

- Promote continuity of care
- Reduce interruptions in a beneficiary's drug therapy due to a change in health plan
- Streamline drug coverage policies and reduce administrative burden for providers
- Facilitate collaboration among health plans

The anticipated timeline for implementation will require all health plan enrollees to transition to the common formulary by October 1, 2016. A MDHHS formulary is available at www.michigan.gov/mdhhs.
