Termination of Federal Rebate Agreement for Xifaxan (Rifaximin) 09/29/2025

Molina Healthcare is alerting providers to the termination of the federal rebate agreement for Xifaxan (rifaximin).

Effective October 1, 2025, claims for Xifaxan (rifaximin) may reject. There are no other rifaximin products with a federal rebate. If members meet criteria for Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic, and Treatment services (EPSDT), providers should request prior authorization (PA) via EPSDT. Members may also be eligible for the manufacturer patient assistance program.
