Asthma Pilot Project Propeller Asthma Medication Management Program

Thank you for being a partner to Molina Healthcare of New Mexico, Inc. (Molina Healthcare), and for taking good care of our Members.

Molina Healthcare is announcing a pilot project launching in April in collaboration with Propeller, a leader in digital platforms for respiratory health management. This program will begin enrolling asthmatic Members. Propeller helps reduce the cost of care while delivering better quality of life for individuals with chronic respiratory disease through the use of sensors, mobile apps and services.

Members enrolled in the Propeller program will receive sensors to attach to their inhalers. The sensors passively track medication use information in real time. Members use the Propeller app or online portal to access information about their medication use.

Molina Healthcare Care Coordinators will be actively reaching out to these Members and may encourage them to contact you, their Primary Care Practitioner (PCP), regarding their asthma controller medications or to schedule an asthma care visit.

PCP's are notified of their patient's enrollment in the Propeller Asthma Program and when any of the following occurs:

- A decline in the Member's asthma control status; and/or
- Non-adherence to controller medications for a period of seven (7) days.
