Colorectal Cancer Screenings –
FOBT (fecal occult blood test) Kits

At Molina Healthcare we believe preventive screenings are the best way to keep Members in good health. The American Cancer Society has found that colon cancer is the third most common cancer in both men and women in the United States. Starting at age fifty (50), both men and women, should have a colon cancer screening test. Molina Healthcare of New Mexico, Inc. (Molina Healthcare) is working with MedXM, a home health vendor, to provide additional colorectal cancer screenings to our Members/your patients. We are offering the InSure® FIT™ test to our Members/your patients so they can complete this test in the comfort of their own home. Our goal is to increase colorectal cancer screenings among our Members/your patients.

FOBT Kit Intervention Steps:

1. All Molina Healthcare Members 50-75 years of age who have not completed an appropriate screening for colorectal cancer will be mailed an FOBT kit.
2. Follow up telephone calls are completed to encourage Members to complete the test. These calls will also help answer any questions the Members may have about completing the kit.
3. Members are asked to complete the kit and mail it back to Quest Diagnostics (Quest).
4. Quest receives the kit and processes lab results.
5. Lab results are then sent to MedXM.
6. MedXM then sends the lab results to the Member's primary care practitioner (PCP) of record.
