Identification and Stratification

Multiple sources are used to identify and stratify program eligible members. These include pharmacy claims, encounter data or paid claims with specific CPT or ICD9 codes. Members may also be self-referred or referred directly from practitioners, Member Services, Case Management, Utilization Management, or the Nurse Advice Line

All enrolled members are stratified by level of risk based upon information available such as prescriptions filled, emergency department visits, inpatient admissions, and out-patient services.
