



A Completed PRAF = A Win/Win for the Provider and Mom

Information for Obstetric and Gynecological providers in the Medicaid network

Molina Healthcare needs your help to ensure that every pregnant woman in your care is linked to needed services, on her very first visit. This can be accomplished by completing the Pregnancy Risk Assessment Form (PRAF) 2.0 (electronic version), for which providers can receive a \$50 incentive.

Your office is eligible for the incentive:

- Existing Molina member after submission of a completed PRAF during the first trimester
- New Molina member within 42 days of initial coverage with Molina Healthcare.

Completed PRAF submissions are important for the care and referral of patients. When vital information is missing it prevents optimum care of mom and baby. Please fill in each blank on the form.

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The Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) created a web-based notification system that allows providers to instantaneously alert County Department of Job and Family Services and Managed Care Plans of a woman's pregnancy. The new "PRAF 2.0 ODM's Online Notification of Pregnancy System" will connect women to needed services, identify women with at-risk pregnancies and prevent interruption of her Medicaid coverage.

As a reminder: Providers can bill for and get reimbursed for completing the PRAF 2.0 for patients using Healthcare Common Procedure Coding System (HCPCS) Code H1000. Providers must file a claim to receive the \$50 incentive at the beginning of the quarter following a live birth, when the PRAF 2.0 submission occurs in the patient's first trimester or within 42 days of enrollment with Molina Healthcare.
