



MOLINA HEALTHCARE CLINICAL PRACTICE GUIDELINE: Use of Medications in the Treatment of Addiction Involving Opioid Use

Molina Healthcare has adopted the Use of Medications in the Treatment of Addiction Involving Opioid Use Guideline from the American Society of Addiction Medicine (ASAM).

The guideline was reviewed and adopted most recently by the Molina Healthcare National Quality Improvement Committee on March 21, 2018.
