CRECIMIENTO Y DESARROLLO Y SALUD CONDUCTUAL**

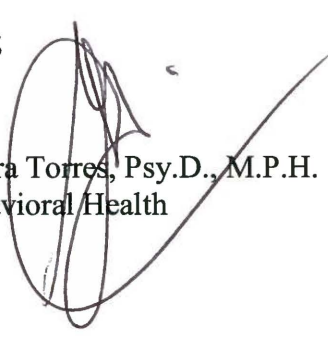
