

# HEDIS® Tips:

## Osteoporosis Management in Women Who Had a Fracture (OMW)

### MEASURE DESCRIPTION

The percentage of women 67-85 years of age who suffered a fracture and who had either a bone mineral density (BMD) test or prescription for a drug to treat osteoporosis in the six months after the fracture.

Other agents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Abaloparatide</li><li>• Raloxifene</li><li>• Denosumab</li><li>• Teriparatide</li></ul>

### HOW TO IMPROVE HEDIS SCORES

- ☐ Order a BMD test on all women with a diagnosis of a fracture within 6 months OR prescribe medication to prevent osteoporosis (e.g., bisphosphonates).
- ☐ Educate patient on safety and fall prevention.
- ☐ Remember, aggressive risk adjustment can overstate osteoporosis by confusing lower Z scores / osteopenia with osteoporosis.
